

Library Tours

Library tours are excellent opportunities to inform participants about the collections, staff, services, and history of the Peter White Public Library. These tours should provide an opportunity for the participants to (1) become acquainted with the library (2) understand the variety of library materials and services available and (3) explore a specific facet of the Peter White Public Library.

Library tours will be booked on a first-come, first-served basis and are subject to the availability of Library staff to conduct the tour.

Tours of the Library:

- Should be booked at least seven days in advance of the visit.
- Conducted by at least one Library staff member.
- Tours should be scheduled during regular Library operating hours. Or – at the discretion of the staff member leading the tour.
- Can be scheduled to meet most timelines. Generally, tours of the building will take 30-45 minutes to complete. This timing depends entirely on how much of the building that the group wishes to see.

Library Tours can be customized to meet the interests of the group. Some topics available include:

- Library hours
- Library card registration and user responsibilities
- Types of materials and services available at the library
- Programming conducted by the library
- The automated library system
- Departments: Circulation, Youth Services, Reference, Cataloging and Acquisitions, and Administration.
- Local History Department
- Special Exhibits and collections
- Digital resources and other information available with library accounts
- Art gallery exhibits
