

The Mission of the Township Advisory Council of the Peter White Public Library is to recommend library services and methods for service delivery to townships served under contract by the Peter White Public Library.

Position Purpose:

To advise the library regarding township library services.

To act as a liaison between the Peter White Public Library Board of Trustees and the Township governing body that the Council Member represents.

Position Appointment:

Township Advisory Council (TAC) members are appointed by the governing body of the township in which they live.

Council membership will be comprised of two (2) members from each township with a valid contract for library services with the Peter White Public Library. Township governing bodies may name alternates in addition to the two appointed Township Advisory Council members.

Council members cannot be removed from the Township Advisory Council unless official action is taken by the township governing body they represent.

Qualifications:

To perform this role successfully, an individual must meet the following qualifications:

- Must be legal residents of the Township they represent.
- Have interest in improving Library Services to township residents.
- Availability to attend evening meetings.
 - Township Advisory Council (TAC) meet quarterly at the Peter White Public Library.
 - Township governing board meetings should be attended on a regular basis.
- Willingness to make reports to the township governing body regarding library news; willingness to make reports to the Peter White Library Board regarding township news.
- Township Advisory Council members should have a strong understanding of their township needs and be willing to advise the library regarding services to township residents.

Application:

Individuals interested in serving on the Peter White Public Library Township Advisory Council on behalf of their home township are encouraged to submit an application to their Township Manager/Supervisor.

Application can be made when vacancies occur, or for general consideration in November for the next calendar year.
